Monthly Manufacturing Performance – September 2021

Highlights

- On a year-on-year basis, Singapore's manufacturing output decreased 3.4% in September 2021. Excluding biomedical manufacturing, output grew 9.4%.
- On a seasonally adjusted month-on-month basis, manufacturing output decreased 2.8% in September 2021. Excluding biomedical manufacturing, output fell 5.1%.

(I) Total Manufacturing Performance

Singapore's manufacturing output decreased 3.4% in September 2021 on a year-on-year basis. Excluding biomedical manufacturing, output increased 9.4%. On a three-month moving average basis, manufacturing output increased 7.2% in September 2021, compared to a year ago. On a seasonally adjusted month-on-month basis, manufacturing output decreased 2.8%. Excluding biomedical manufacturing, output fell 5.1%.

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(II) Performance by cluster

- 2. Precision engineering: Output increased 30.2% in September 2021 compared to the same period in 2020, with both segments recording output growth. The machinery & systems segment grew 38.4% with higher output of semiconductor and industrial process equipment. The precision modules & components segment rose 13.5% with increased production of optical products, plastic and metal precision components as well as dies, moulds, tools, jigs and fixtures. Overall, the precision engineering cluster grew 21.0% in the first nine months of 2021 compared to the same period last year.
- 3. Transport engineering: Output expanded 12.9% in September 2021 compared to a year ago. The aerospace and marine & offshore engineering segments rose 21.7% and 9.9% respectively. The levels of activity in the aerospace firms and shipyards had increased compared to last year where the volume of work was adversely affected by international travel restrictions and the weak global oil & gas market respectively amid the COVID-19 pandemic. Cumulatively, the transport engineering cluster grew 5.6% in the period January September 2021 compared to the same period last year.
- 4. Chemicals: Output grew 12.4% year-on-year in September 2021 with all segments recording output growth except the specialties segment. The petroleum and petrochemicals segments expanded 26.1% and 18.6% respectively from a year ago, when production was weighed down by plant maintenance shutdowns and weaker export demand amid the COVID-19 outbreak. The other chemicals segment rose 9.9% with higher production of fragrances. Conversely, the specialties segment recorded a decline of 1.5%. Overall, the chemicals cluster grew 9.6% year-on-year in the period January September 2021.
- 5. Electronics: Output increased 4.9% year-on-year in September 2021. Except for the computer peripherals & data storage segment, all segments recorded output growth.

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On a year-to-date basis, the electronics cluster grew 17.7% compared to the same period in 2020.

- General manufacturing: Output decreased 2.7% in September 2021 on a year-on-year basis. The miscellaneous industries segment grew 21.0% from a low base last year, when demand for construction-related products was adversely affected by COVID-19. By contrast, the printing and food, beverage & tobacco segments fell 14.5% and 16.0% respectively, with the latter recording lower production of milk products due to plant maintenance shutdowns and weaker export demand. In the first nine months of this year, output of the general manufacturing industries cluster grew 6.8%, compared to the same period in 2020.
- 7. Biomedical manufacturing: Output contracted 35.9% in September 2021 compared to the same period in 2020. The medical technology segment rose 2.4% with sustained export demand for medical devices. On the other hand, the pharmaceuticals segment declined 46.2% on account of a different mix of active pharmaceutical ingredients being produced compared to a year ago. On a year-to-date basis, the biomedical manufacturing cluster grew 1.4% compared to the same period a year ago.
